A: Then You did forgive the guilt of my sin.

P: The Lord is gracious and merciful.

A: Slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

P: The Lord is good to all.

- A: And His compassion is over all that He has made.
- **P:** All Your works shall give thanks to You, O Lord.
- A: And all your saints shall bless You.
- **P:** The Lord is near to all who call upon Him.
- A: To all who call upon Him in truth.
- **P:** He fulfills the desire of all who fear Him
- A: He also hears their cry and saves them.
- **P:** The Lord preserves all who love Him.
- A: But all the wicked He will destroy.
- **P:** My mouth will speak the praise of the Lord.
- A: And let all flesh bless His holy name forever and ever.
